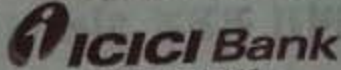

Man duped of Rs 45,000 over promise of Domino's franchise on fake website

THE AHMEDABAD Cyber Crime Police has lodged a case of cheating based on the complaint of a city-based person who was duped of Rs 45,000 by an unknown person who allegedly used a fake website of Domino's Pizza and tried to sell the victim a "franchise" of the company.

Cyber Crime officials said that 23-year-old Ahmedabad-based businessman Shrey Panchal said in his complaint recently that a person claiming to be a representative of Domino's Pizza had sought Rs 45,000 from him as "registration fees" to open a franchise of the pizza chain in Ahmedabad.

The victim also contacted Jubilant Foodworks Limited, which holds the master franchise of Domino's India, regarding the

alleged fraud, after which a first information report was lodged at Ahmedabad Cyber Crime Police station at the behest of the company on October 23.

Speaking to *The Indian Express*, Panchal said that he contacted the accused on a toll-free number he found on a website www.dominosfranchises.com. In reality, the genuine web domain of Domino's India is www.dominos.co.in.

"When I clicked on the website, I found a toll-free number where I called and inquired regarding how to own a franchise

of Domino's Pizza in Ahmedabad," Panchal said. "I was contacted by a person who introduced himself as 'Vipul Sharma, the supervisor manager of Dominos India'. He said that the registration charge would come around Rs 45,000 and advance would be Rs 3,75,000. He gave me a bank account number where I submitted Rs 45,000. We stayed in touch for one month, where he kept demanding that I transfer the advance amount as well," he added. "It was only recently that I realised that a fraud had been done, when I contacted Jubilant Foodworks Limited and they informed me that they don't sell franchises and that there is no person called Vipul Sharma in their company."

Police have lodged a case of fraud and breach of trust as per Indian Penal Code sections 420 and 406 respectively against an unknown person. Although po-

lice currently have the bank account number and its IFSC code to which Panchal had transferred the money, they are investigating further before they can release the details.

The police said they are not releasing details of the account holder as, in many instances, fraudsters use the bank account numbers of unsuspecting elderly persons who are known to them to carry out such illegal activity. The police also suspect that there might be a bigger network of fraudsters involved in this type of scam as the accused used a toll-free number to dupe the clients. It takes a minimum of Rs 20,000 rent per six months to open a basic toll-free number starting with the digits 1800.

"We are using surveillance to find out the location of the accused and our probe is going on," an official of the Cyber Crime Branch said.

Anyone could enter from Pak under mauni Manmohan: Shah

CALLING FORMER Prime Minister Manmohan Singh "mauni (silent) baba Manmohan", Union Home Minister Amit Shah on Saturday said that any "aaliya, maliya, jamaaliya (any Tom, Dick and Harry)" from Pakistan could enter India during Shah's tenure.

But when Narendra Modi took over as the Prime Minister, "...there were attacks on Uri, Pulwama, and within 10 days Narendrabhai ordered our soldiers to enter Pakistan and eliminate the terrorists by entering their homes..."

Speaking at an event to inaugurate multiple projects in Ahmedabad, amounting Rs 800 crore, Shah said, "Congress nu shashan hatu, mauni baba Manmohan vadapradhan hatha, Pakistan thi aaliya, maliya jamaaliya ghusi jata. Sena nu jawan na maatha kaapi deta ane apmanit karta... (when silent baba Manmohan was the PM, anyone would enter from Pakistan, attack our soldiers and decapitate them and humiliate us...)"

Shah on Saturday laid the foundation stone for and inaugurated several projects helmed by the Ahmedabad Municipal Corporation (AMC) and the Ahmedabad Urban Development Authority. Several municipal corporations in

Gujarat, including the AMC, are due for elections next year.

Shah took on the Opposition not only on lack of delivery of welfare schemes but also other aspects such as foreign policy, on the legacy of Sardar Patel and abrogation of special status to J&K under Article 370.

"Sardar Patel, who integrated 629 kings and princes to make India one place, missed in Kashmir... In five-six years, Narendrabhai removed (Article) 370 and 35A to complete India. With this, the road to development in Kashmir has opened... I

want to tell Congress leaders that (since the Centre's decision on J&K on August 5) not a single bullet has been fired, not a single death has occurred in Kashmir."

"Since 2014, Narendrabhai has been working on building respect for our country the world over. He goes to America, China, Russia, Australia, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, Nepal, Bangladesh... wherever he goes, he is welcomed with chants of 'Modi Modi'. This makes the Congress jealous. I want to tell my friends (in Congress) that the welcome is not for Modi, it is not for the BJP's symbol; this welcome is for the prosperity of 125 crore Indians..."

He also said, "When we spoke of making toilets, Congress leaders mocked us, saying we are working on developing toilets in the 21st century. I am proud that Narendrabhai provided 10 crore poor families with toilets."

Taking on the Nehru-Gandhi family without naming them, the Home Minister said, "With four generations born with chandi na chamcha (silver spoon), they are not aware of the plight of the poor... Narendrabhai was born into a poor family and understands the plight of the poor. That is why the poor today have received gas connections, electricity, toilets, affordable housing, bank accounts, health-care and medical facilities..."

On the Statue of Unity, Shah said, "As Sardar Patel's statue touches the sky, one realises that for 70 years, Sardar had to deal with injustice, which has been recovered with interest today

with the Statue of Unity..." Later in the day, Shah also visited the Sola Civil Hospital where he interacted with Ayushman Bharat beneficiaries.

In Sanand and Bavla region, the Union Home Minister inaugurated projects worth Rs 78 crore, including a CCTV surveillance project, Laxman lake development, 172 houses under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana, a crematorium, a minor bridge, anganwadis and 49 kilometers of roads in these two regions. Over 5,000 widows enrolled for the state government's pension scheme were present during the event organised at the APMC market at Sanand.

In Sanand town, he inaugurated and laid the foundation stones for projects, including lake development, construction of state roads and installation of CCTVs. As many as 5,532 widows were distributed benefits of pension scheme while 172 families were allotted houses under the PMAY. In Ahmedabad, Shah held a meeting with officials of the postal and railway departments in the evening. He met officials of Ahmedabad postal circle and the railway officials of Ahmedabad division at the Circuit House Annex. He asked the railway officials in Ahmedabad to hold meetings with their counterparts in Delhi and expedite the pending railway works in the Ahmedabad division, said an official release. In his meeting with post office officials, he reviewed the Sukanya Samruddhi Yojana for girl child being implemented by post offices in the Ahmedabad circle.

The re-measurement of accumulated deferred tax asset has resulted in a one-time additional charge of ₹ 2,919.75 crore in standalone financial results and ₹ 2,970.08 crore (net of minority interest) in consolidated financial results in Q2-2020 and H1-2020.

1984 ANTI-SIKH RIOTS Four families move HC for compensation

EXPRESS NEWS SERVICE AHMEDABAD, OCTOBER 26

MEMBERS OF four Sikh families in the city, who were affected by the 1984 anti-Sikh riots following then Prime Minister Indira Gandhi's assassination, filed a petition with the Gujarat High Court seeking relief on Friday. It is expected to be heard after the Diwali vacation, said the petitioners' lawyer, Dharmesh Gargur.

Sardar Jagjitsingh Khanuja from Maninagar, Sardar Satbir-singh Dug from Bapunagar, Sardar Malkitsingh Shikh from Ghodasar and Sardar Devendra-palsingh Dug from Ghodasar of four families said in their petition that around 60 families were affected in the riots in Ahmedabad.

The petition seeks the HC's direction to the respondents, including the central government, the district collector and the state government, to investigate and pay appropriate compensation. The petitioners said that they made several representations to the governments for payment of compensation to 60 Sikh families whose properties and business establishments were affected in arson, looting and other untoward incidents. They said there were two casualties also in the incidents.

The petition said, "...the state of Gujarat has not taken proper initiative in the matter by putting correct facts of casualties and damage to properties in the riots and therefore, 60 Sikh families remain without help or relief of rehabilitation package, which was sponsored by the central government and extended to other parts of the country... almost 31 years have passed but no government has taken care to consider the hardship and agony of the victim families, who were punished for no fault of theirs..."
