	Feature	Debit Card	ATM Card
-	Usage	A debit card can be used not only for transactions across all banks and ATMs but also for making payment at merchant establishments that accept card payments.	An ATM card can be used only at ATMs of select banks for cash withdrawal and other transactions pertaining to your account but not for making payment at merchant establishments.
	Reach	Debit Cards are widely accepted globally through the VISA/MasterCard network and across all banks' ATM networks. In India there are more than 7,70,000 merchant establishments that accept debit cards.	ATM cards can be used at select banks' ATM networks for cash withdrawal.
	Convenience	With a debit card, you can travel with minimum cash in your wallet because the widespread acceptance of the debit card makes carrying a debit card as good as carrying cash.	An ATM card is not accepted at merchant establishments; hence its coverage is restricted.
	Online Facilities	Many banks have enabled their debit cards for online transactions like train/air-ticket booking, online shopping, etc.	With the ATM Card, you can only withdraw cash from ATMs.
