How can you safeguard yourself against Phishing?



- Never respond to any e-mail that requires you to confirm, renew or validate your account details or card details, even if it appears to have come from your bank.
- Do not enter your confidential data in any window that may pop-up while you are carrying out an online financial transaction.
- Always remember to log off once you have completed a session. Avoid financial transactions from a cyber café or shared computer.
- Register for e-mail alerts and mobile alerts to get to know well in time about transactions or any changes in your account.
- Do not ignore any SMS alert sent by your bank. Check your bank statements regularly. If you notice an unauthorised transaction in your bank account or card account, report it to your bank immediately.

Your bank will never ask you for personal confidential details through e-mails or pop-ups.
