## Vax centre dumps 800 expired shots

Pune: A private vaccination centre at Kasarwadi in Maharashtra's Pimpri Chinchwad was forced to discard 800 Covishield doses after vials crossed the expiry date, members of the Indian Medical Association confirmed on Thursday. The members said the incident may be the first recorded instance of preventable bulk vaccine wastage and added many more such cases are likely if the government does not address the issue of large unused reserves at private hospitals. The IMA had earlier estimated that as many as 50 lakh Covishield doses are likely to be wasted across private hospitals in the country due to imminent expiry dates.
