

Authorities nab man from Pauri for duping seven foreigners during pandemic

The cyber police and Special Task Force (STF) of Uttarakhand nabbed a man in Srinagar for allegedly duping seven people from Europe and Central America during Covid-19 pandemic period by posing as a travel agent from Rishikesh. The Deputy Superintendent of Police (DSP) of Cyber Crime of STF, Ankush Mishra informed that the cyber police received an email from these seven victims who mentioned that they connected to a man through internet who posed as a travel agent and for a total of Rs 7,32,527 assured to book their tickets and provide other facilities. They paid the amount but he duped them, as per the complainants. Mishra informed that the cyber



police started the investigation and finally nabbed the culprit Anurag Uniyal, a resident of Pauri district on Sunday. He said that the complainants have sent a thank you email to the police after they were informed about these developments in this case. The DSP informed that the Spanish police have also thanked the police here for catching the culprit.

The DSP appealed to the people to take the help of police or dial 1930 in case of

any cyber fraud rather than taking steps on their own.

The police presented the accused in court from where he was sent to judicial custody. The police informed that the Srinagar police registered a case against 33-year old Uniyal under section 420 of Indian Penal Code on the report lodged by cyber crime police station Dehradun sub-inspector Rajesh Dhyani. The investigation by sub-inspector Manoj Rawat ascertained the allegations to be true. Uniyal had set up Rishikesh Vibes tour agency and had defrauded the foreigners of Rs 7.32 lakh. The accused was arrested in Srinagar on a tip off received by the police.

Driver injured after truck falls into gorge

The driver of a dumper truck was injured after the vehicle fell into a gorge on the Dhumkot-Bhoom motor road. The accident occurred in the remote area of Pauri district early on Monday morning. The injured driver 40-year old Hariom, a resident of Almora district was admitted for treatment in the primary health centre at Dhumkot.

On receiving the information of this road accident, The Dhumkot police station in-charge Deepak Tiwari reached the site with police team and rescue equipment. The police rescue the injured person with the help of local people. According to the police, the vehicle fell down the road due to the weak retaining wall of the road which was constructed with mud.



HC directs State to clarify in alleged hate speech case

Hearing on the bail application of Wasim Rizvi alias Jitendra Narayan Tyagi who is accused of hate speech at an event in Haridwar, the Uttarakhand high court has directed the state government to clarify the position by February 23. The next hearing on the application will be held on February 25. The matter was taken up for hearing by the single bench of justice RC Khulbe.

According to the case details, resident of Jwalapur in Haridwar, Nadeem Ali had lodged a complaint with the Haridwar police on January 2. He had stated in the complaint that a Dharm Sansad programme was held in Haridwar from December 17 to 19 last year. Some of the speakers had made objectionable statements targeting a particular community, the complainant had



alleged. Later, the videos of Rizvi, Yati Narsinghanand and others also went viral on the social media. The complainant stated that the inflammatory speeches had disturbed the peace in the district while also causing embarrassment at the national and international level. Acting on the complaint, the police lodged a case against Rizvi, Narsinghanand and others under sections 153 A and 295 of the Indian Penal Code for hate speech in the Haridwar event. Rizvi has approached the high court seeking bail and quashing of the FIR.

Steps to prevent forest fires discussed in Tehri district

A district-level forest fire meeting presided over by the Tehri district magistrate Eva Ashish Srivastava was held through video conferencing at the district administration hall on Monday. In the meeting, an action plan of Rs.1204.06 lakh under the district fire plan to prevent forest fires was approved by the district level committee headed by the district magistrate. The total expenditure amount of Rs.695.20 lakh proposed by the district magistrate for the year 2022-23 was approved on the occasion.

The district magistrate directed the forest department officials to provide details of demand for equipment and vehicles for forest protection without any delay so that the same are provided soon. She also said that the public representatives, Pradhans, Van Panchayats and field staff of the forest department of civil areas and Van Panchayats who are able to mitigate incidents of forest fires will be felicitated on August 15 this year. She directed that additional registrations be done in the FSI Fire Alert on



the website of the Forest Survey of India so that immediate action can be taken against the fire incidents in forest areas. She said that all the departments concerned should ensure that people are involved in the FSI fire alert by conducting mass awareness workshops at the village level also in coordination with each other. Srivastava directed the departments of Revenue, Disaster Management, Police, Medical Health, Traffic, Fire, Public Works Department,

Telecommunication, Power and others to publicise on a large scale the prevention measures being adopted by forest department.

Forest department officials informed about division-wise forest area, range-wise forest area, reasons for forest fire incidents, forest fire incidents of past years, forest management, regulation, and controlled works among other aspects. It was stated that normally, every year, the month of forest fire lasts from February

15 to June 15 or till the onset of regular rains and causes damage to the valuable forest wealth, wildlife and environment.

Sensitisation towards the issue through Van Panchayat members and at school level through seminars and street plays should be facilitated. Publicity through poster slogans on the importance of forest and fire safety appeal to prevent forest fires through means of media should be initiated.

To control incidents of forest fire a master control room for the district will be set up in Tehri forest division, New Tehri with contact numbers 7078209400 and 01376232077. Further, each range of each forest division will have a range control room in which the information system will be activated. A total of 176 crew stations have been set up in the district, out of which 48 are in Tehri forest division, 69 in Narendranagar forest division, 22 in Mussoorie forest division along with more crew stations in New Tehri, Tehri Dam forest division and soil conservation section. Regular fire drills will be conducted by the staff and fire watchers so they are able to control incidents of forest fires.

Divisional Forest Officer of Narendranagar Rajiv Dhiman, Chief Medical Officer Dr Sanjay Jain, ASP Rajan Singh, DDO Sunil Kumar, SDO Mussoorie Forest Division Subhash Chandra Verma, District Youth Welfare Officer Pankaj Tiwari and other departmental officials were present in the meeting.
