Ukraine crisis- U'khand to provide free transport facility to returnees

The Uttarakhand government has decided that people hailing from Uttarakhand who are returning from Ukraine would be transported free of cost from Delhi towards their destinations.

The officiating chief secretary Radha Raturi said on Wednesday that information about 282 people of Uttarakhand living in Ukraine has been received by the state administration so far and out of them more than 30 have returned home safely. She said this while chairing a meeting of all district magistrates (DM) via video conferencing on the day. In the meeting she directed all DMs to remain in constant touch with the family members of the students and others stranded in Ukraine and inform the state administration and Delhi based resident commissioner of Uttarakhand about their current location.

She further informed that coordination centres have been set up in Delhi and Mumbai by Uttarakhand. Arrangements are made for the stay of the guests and the state government has made arrangements to transport the students from Delhi to their destinations. In

Weather in State set to take a turn again today

A fter a brief spell of balmy and clear days in most degrees Celsius respectively in parts of the state, the weather is forecast to take a turn once again on Thursday. The State meteorological centre has issued a yellow alert regarding the possibility of thunderstorm accompanied with hail/lightning likely to occur at isolated places in the districts of Uttarakhand on Thursday. Apart from this, very light to light rainfall / thunderstorm / snowfall are likely to occur at a few places in districts of Garhwal region along with Bageshwar and Pithoragarh districts of Kumaon region today. Further, very light to light rainfall / thunderstorm / snowfall are likely to occur at isolated places in remaining

districts of Uttarakhand. Snowfall is likely to occur at places situated at altitudes of 3,500 metres and above. The provisional State capital Dehradun is forecast to experience partly to generally cloudy sky with the possibility of light rain/thunderstorm which is likely to occur in some areas. The maximum and minimum temperatures are likely to be about 27

The state Health department reported 65 new patients of Covid-19 and death of one patient from the disease in Uttarakhand on Wednesday. It also declared 130 patients cured from the disease on the day. The state now has only 589 active cases of the disease.

The department has so far detected 91,462 new cases of the disease from January 1 this year till date. A total of 87,145 patients have recovered from the disease so far in this year while 266 patients have died in the state since January I this year. The recovery percentage of the disease was at 95.28 on Wednesday. The positivity rate of the disease was reported at 0.82 per cent on the day. The authorities reported the death of one patient from Covid-19 in

The health department reported 22 new patients from Dehradun, 10 from

Champawat and six from Haridwar on Wednesday. The districts of Almora, Nainital, Pithoragarh and Uttarkashi reported one case each of the disease on the day.

The active case count of Covid-19 in the state is now at 859. Dehradun with 319 cases is at the top of the table of active cases while Pauri has 121 active cases of the disease. Uttarkashi now has come at the bottom of the table with only three active cases of the disease. In the ongoing vaccination drive 9,319 people were vaccinated in 685 sessions in the state held on Wednesday.

The association has writ-

ten the letter considering the recent accident in Vikasnagar area in which a 12-year-old school girl lost her life after the school bus allegedly crashed into a tree. The association has leveled allegations against the authorities concerned for being negligent towards the regular monitoring of school buses. The president of the association Arif Khan said that the SC has issued guidelines for the operation of school buses and a monitoring committee has also been set up in every state which include the members from the education department but despite that, the department here has failed to take any cognisance of the operation of the school buses. Such negligence led to the recent accident in Vikasnagar in which a young girl lost her life while another school boy got seriously injured after the school bus which has the capacity to carry only 42 students was carrying about 70 students, alleged Khan. He said that the police and transfocus on the fact that it is actually the school management that allows the operation of buses without proper maintenance while stuffing students in them like animals. Also, what happened to the protocol of following physical distancing? The school has violated several laws and the authorities should take strict action against the management," said Khan.

In order to avoid recurrence of such accident in future, NAPSR has appealed to SCPCR to issue orders to the authorities concerned to conduct proper investigation under the Protection of Child Rights Act and to check the arbitrariness of schools as well as to the departments concerned to implement the guidelines of the Supreme Court. Khan informed that the union has also written to the district magistrate of Dehradun and chief education officer besides SCPCR to ensure the strict adherence of the guidelines issued by SC for school buses.

Wet waste can be used to prepare compost while the dry waste can be kept separately for recycling. It is a simple task that can bring a significant change in the city. It will also help the city to become garbage free, stated the
