

14 dead as coalition bombs Yemen after UAE attack

Director of rebels' air force academy among those killed in air strikes; crude prices soar to seven-year high partly due to Abu Dhabi attacks

THE Saudi-led coalition killed 14 people in air strikes on Yemen's rebel-held capital, a medical source said on Tuesday, after an attack by Houthi insurgents on the United Arab Emirates sent regional tensions soaring.

Sanaa residents were combing the rubble for survivors of the strikes that levelled houses, hours after the Houthis had killed three people on Monday in a drone and missile attack on the UAE capital Abu Dhabi.

Houthi Brigadier General Abdullah Qassem Al-Junaid, director of the rebels' air force academy, was killed along with family members, the rebels' Saba news agency said.

Coalition forces launched further strikes on Sanaa on Tuesday. "The search is still going on for survivors in the rub-

ble," said a relative of several of the victims.

The UAE, part of the Saudi-led coalition fighting the Iran-backed rebels, had vowed a tough response to Monday's attack, the first deadly assault acknowledged inside its borders and claimed by the Yemeni insurgents. The attack on UAE, which opened a new front in the seven-year war, followed a surge in fighting in Yemen including battles between the rebels and UAE-trained troops.

Crude prices soared to seven-year highs partly because of the Abu Dhabi attacks, which exploded fuel tanks near storage facilities of oil giant ADNOC. The Houthi later warned UAE residents to avoid "vital installations". Yemen, whose nearly seven-year-old war has killed hundreds of thousands, occupies a strategic position on

the Red Sea, a vital conduit for oil from the resource-rich Gulf. After the attacks, Saudi Arabia's de facto ruler, Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman, and Abu Dhabi Crown Prince Mohamed bin Zayed agreed in a phone call to "jointly stand up to these acts of aggression", UAE state media said. The Abu Dhabi attack marked a new phase in the Yemen war and further reduced hopes of any resolution to the conflict, which has displaced millions in what was already the Arabian peninsula's poorest country.

The US pledged to hold Houthis accountable, while Britain, France and European Union also condemned the assault. The targeting of Abu Dhabi followed intense clashes in Yemen, including advances by the UAE-trained Giants Brigade, who drove the rebels out of Shabwa province. AFP



British PM denies lying to Parl about lockdown party

LONDON

UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson on Tuesday "categorically" rejected claims by his former chief aide that he lied to parliament last week about a Downing Street party held during a strict lockdown.

But appearing in public for the first time after days of Covid self-isolation, Johnson also ducked questions about whether he would resign if it is established by an internal inquiry that he did lie.

"I can tell you categorically that nobody told me, nobody said this was something that was against the rules, that it was a breach of the Covid rules, that it was something that wasn't a work event," he said. "Frankly, I can't imagine why on earth it would have been allowed to go ahead," Johnson added.

Johnson is battling damaging allegations that he and staff attended boozy events during lockdowns, prompting public and political fury.

He has apologised for a May 20, 2020, party in the Downing Street garden, telling parliament last week he had not known about it in advance and "believed implicitly that this was a work event". But his combative former senior adviser Dominic Cummings, who has been waging a vendetta against Johnson since he was sacked in Nov 2020, said he warned his then boss about the event at the time.

Foreign parcels brought in Omicron, suspects China

BEIJING

CHINESE state media say parcels mailed from overseas may have spread the omicron variant of the coronavirus in Beijing and elsewhere, despite doubts among overseas health experts that the virus can be transmitted via packaging.

The State Post Bureau said it has ordered stronger measures to ventilate and disinfect sites where items mailed from overseas are handled. Postal workers must wear protective equipment, receive booster shots and undergo regular testing, it said on its website. International packages must be isolated, cleaned and held for a waiting period to ensure they are free from the virus, it said. Global health experts say the virus mainly spreads through respiratory droplets when infected people breathe, speak, cough and sneeze.

The World Health Organization says coronavirus "needs a live animal or human host to multiply and survive and cannot multiply on the surface of food packages". However, China has repeatedly emphasised what it calls the danger of in-

fections from packaging, despite only trace amounts of the virus being found on such items, and has boosted testing of frozen food and other items shipped from overseas.

The Communist Party newspaper 'Global Times' cited the Beijing Center for Disease Control and virologists as linking recent infections to packages from abroad. It said on Tuesday that investigators found people newly infected had picked up packages mailed from Canada and the U.S.

China has locked down parts of Beijing's Haidian district following the detection of four cases, just weeks before the capital is to host the Winter Olympic Games. Another person in the southern technology hub of Shenzhen who tested positive for omicron handled packages sent from North America, the newspaper said. An additional case was reported in the city's Chaoyang district, and an office building in Shunyi, where capital's main airport is located, was placed under lockdown with all inside required to undergo testing after a case was reported. EU parl gets its third female president

BRUSSELS

ROBERTA METSOLA, a Christian Democrat from Malta, was elected president of the European Union's parliament on Tuesday, putting women in three of the four biggest jobs in the 27-nation bloc. Metsola succeeds Italian Socialist David Sassoli, who died last week. She is only the third woman elected to the post. Her birthday was Tuesday, and at age 43, she is the European Parliament's youngest president.

Metsola was the candidate of the parliament's biggest group, and she received 458 of the 616 votes cast on Tuesday. She had already been acting president since Sassoli's demise on January 11.

"I know that having the first female president of this house since 1999 matters both inside and outside these rooms, but it must go further," Metsola told the plenary.

"Our institution commits to having more diversity, gender equality, guaranteeing women's rights, all our rights must be reaffirmed."

Sri Lankan president promises rights reforms, justice for missing persons

PRESIDENT Gotabaya Rajapaksa said on Tuesday that Sri Lanka needs to "correct the misconceptions" of the international community on its human rights policies as he promised "justice" for missing persons from the three-decade-long civil war with the LTTE.

"We reject racism. The present government wants to safeguard the dignity and rights of every citizen in this country in a uniform manner," Rajapaksa said while addressing a new session of Parliament. "Therefore, I urge those politicians who continue to incite people against each other for narrow political gains to stop doing so," he said.

Talking about human rights issues in the country, Rajapaksa said that he was willing to take suggestions from the international community on it.

"We need to correct the misconceptions that have been taken to the international community in the past regarding our human rights," he said.

"I say with responsibility that during my tenure, the government did not support any form of human rights violations. We will also not leave room for any such act in the future. We do not condone such actions in any manner," he added.

The Lankan government's

reluctance to address or investigate human rights allegations from the civil war has been a source of tension in its ties with several Western countries. Rajapaksa, who so far sidestepped calls to investigate missing persons from the civil war, said that the issue is not something unique to a particular group. "We will do maximum justice on behalf of all such persons," he said. According to the Lankan

government figures, over 20,000 people are missing due to various conflicts including the three-decade separatist war with Lankan Tamils which claimed at least 100,000 lives.



Sudanese protest after 7 killed in anti-coup stir

KHARTOUM

SUDANESE shuttered shops and barricaded streets with burning tyres and rocks on Tuesday, staging angry rallies to protest against one of the bloodiest days since a coup derailed the country's democratic transition. Security forces on Monday opened fire killing at least seven people as thousands marched against the army's October 25 takeover, taking the total number killed in a crackdown since the coup to 71, according to medics. "No, no to military rule," protesters chanted on Tuesday in southern Blue Nile state, where some carried banners daubed with the slogan "No to killing peaceful protesters", said witness Omar Eissa. The protests come as Washington ramps up pressure in a bid to broker an end to the months-long crisis in the northeast African nation, with top US diplomats expected to arrive in the capital Khartoum for talks.

Sudan's main civilian bloc, the Forces for Freedom and Change, called for two days of civil disobedience to begin on Tuesday. "Shop closed for mourning," signs read at Khartoum's sprawling Sajane construction supplies market.
